## **1 TRAILERS**

Trailers must be unloaded and parked at Barony College in accordance with the diagram which appears in the Road Book and Service Book and which also forms page 4 of this document. Copies of this diagram will be given to each service crew on arrival at Barony College. Trailers should be parked as far down the trailer park as possible.

## **2 DOCUMENTATION**

Competitors should collect competition numbers and rally plates prior to scrutineering and must present their cars with these decals in place. Numbers and rally plates will be available from a dedicated desk inside the Sports Hall at Barony College, which will be manned from 10:00 on Friday 25 June. Competition numbers must be affixed as high as possible below the window on each front door, with the number towards the front of the car (i.e. to the left of the rally title on the nearside, and to the right on the offside).

Documentation will take place in the Sports Hall on the ground floor of Barony College and competitors may complete this procedure at any time between 16:00 and 21:00 on Friday 25 June once their car has passed scrutineering. Each competitor will be issued with a start card following successful completion of documentation and scrutineering.

## **3 SCRUTINEERING**

Scrutineering will be located at Barony College, and will be open from 16:00 on Friday 25 June. Before arriving at scrutineering, competitors must satisfactorily complete the sound test, which will also be located at Barony College and will be open from 15:30 on Friday 25 June.

At the sound test, competitors will be issued with a scrutineering card, the top section of which should be completed in all respects before proceeding to scrutineering.

Competitors must queue as directed by marshals outside the scrutineering area. To comply with fire regulations, competing cars must have only the minimum amount of fuel in their tanks when reporting to scrutineering. No changing or topping up of oil will be allowed inside the scrutineering area. There must be no smoking in the scrutineering area.

The timetable for scrutineering appears on Page 3 of this Competitors' Information sheet.

## 6 TIME CARDS

Time cards will be issued at the pre-start holding area (see Road Book) in exchange for a start card. Scheduled start times from MC 0 will be displayed on the official notice board.

## 7 SOCIAL EVENTS

All competitors are invited to a reception hosted by Dumfries & Galloway Council at Barony College on Saturday 26 June. A buffet will be served from 17:30. This will incorporate the presentation of awards which will begin at 19:00. Prizewinners are requested to attend the presentation as a courtesy to the organisers and sponsors.

## 8 ENVIRONMENTAL SPILL KITS

Competitors are reminded that they are required to carry an environmental spill kit. Kits will be on sale at the sound test for any competitors not in possession of one. This kit must be carried in the competing car at all times and should be used in the event of a spillage on a stage or in a service area.

Competitors having to use their kit in a stage or on a road section must ensure that the bag is securely tied before disposing of it in a container at a "spill station" which is located at each service area. Replacement kits are available for competitors who have used the original one.

## 9 SHAKEDOWN

There will be a shakedown special stage in the Forest of Ae, eight miles north-east of Dumfries, on Friday 25 June. This stage will be approximately two miles long and will be run to full MSA safety standards. Competitors wishing to take part should contact Jonathan Lord at the Rally Office by Monday 21 June. The cost of participation in the Shakedown will be £100 per car. It is a condition of taking part that competitors should allow members of the media and guests of the Organisers to travel in their cars for a minimum of two runs if asked to do so by the Organisers. The Shakedown will begin at 10:00 with a low-speed reconnaissance and will continue until 14:30.

Smoking is not permitted in any of the buildings on the Barony College campus or in the quad area.



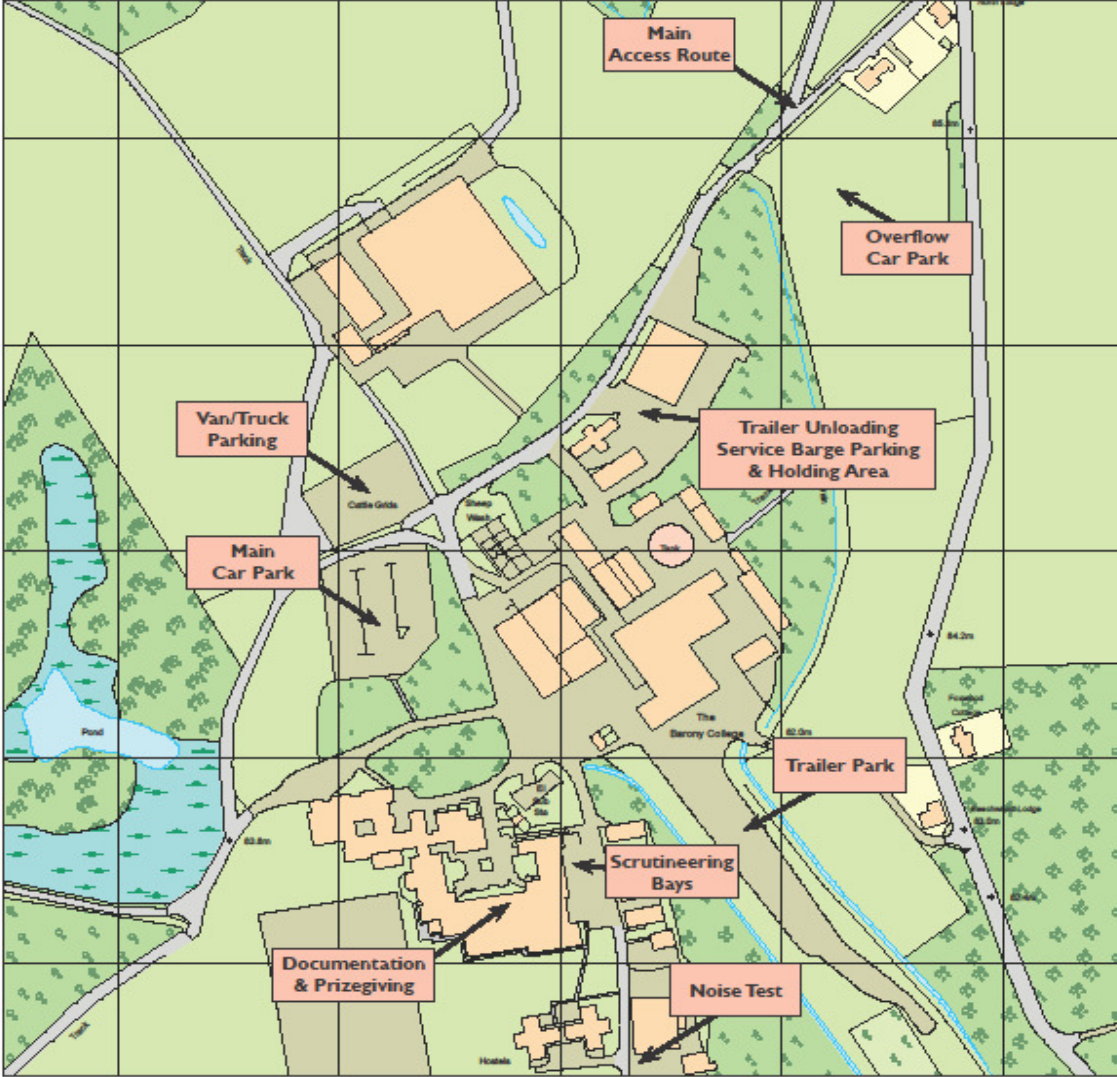
